Railroad Marine Operations: Tugboat, Steamboat & Riverboats

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This list includes companies that owned, used, provided access to or controlled steamships, barges, tug boats, ferry boats, or ferry terminals in their operations. This list also includes Bridges or Bridge companies; in many cases, the railroad arrived at a location before a bridge could be built across the river. Bridges cost a great deal of money, and for this reason, construction had to wait. Meanwhile, the only way of completing the railroad, was to establish a temporary car ferry service across the river.

During the period from about 1870 until the 1920's, the railroads (primarily in the east) provided extensive steamship , ferry boat and other water transport to extend their "single owner transportation". For the most part, steamships and other "went where the railroad didn't", Some vessels were designed for operation at sea, while others were designed for operation on lakes and rivers. Many others were designed as car floats used in transporting freight cars across bays. The ere of marine operations continued for some railroads into the 1970s and 1980s in the New York, San Francisco-Oakland Bay area, and and a few other locations before coming to an end.
