**Instructions for Use:** Enter in the "Search" box the full or partial name of a City, County, Country or Facility name (ie, "Moffat Tunnel", "30th St. Yard", "Altoona Shops", etc) . 2 char State/Province codes should be preceded by a blank and followed by a blank; ie, Alberta =" AB ") and press the "Tab" key; the program will return all City, State, or Country names beginning with the search term entered. **See end of report for Foreign countries.** Rows highlighted in **Black Bold Face** with **Green** background contain references to Photographs, Postcards, Diagrams/Drawings, Illustrations, Maps, or Track Diagrams. Rows highlighted in yellow are key locations: long tunnels historic loc, etc. To find the County a city is located in, or to find the cities in a given County, press the "County Finder" bar at the top, far right. To find the Zip code for a given city, press the "Zip Code Finder" above.
